Cheetah Educational

The Game Reserve is home to a cheetah sanctuary, offering a unique opportunity to learn about the world's fastest land animal, the African cheetah. Marvel at their incredible running exercise, with speeds reaching up to 120 km/h, and gain insight into the reserve's renowned cheetah conservation initiatives. Please note that the cheetah run is separate from the educational experience
